Council met in regular session with the following council members present: Heslop, Crouch, Conis and Acuff. Absent: Lass. Mayor Burton presided.

One change made to minutes: Acuff was not looking into road repair, Heslop was. Motion by Conis, seconded by Acuff to approve the minutes and treasurer's report. Unanimous vote.

Communications: The Bridge report that the City received has been taken over by the county. They will proceed with the recommendation and will let the city know what action they will be taking.

Old Business:

The tree that is in the way of the new park border was looked at and we were given a quote of \$100 to take it down. That would leave the stump and the wood for the city to deal with. The city clerk is looking into more options.

Heslop talked to Fort Dodge Asphalt about 2nd street and they said they would take a core sample to see what action they would recommend taking to repair the road. He also spoke with a gentleman about a cement option for \$3.85 a foot. We are awaiting more information to make a decision.

Mark F is no longer living in the area to repair the tractor the City owns. He was willing to give us the name of someone he would recommend. Crouch is following up with the lead.

The City is looking to update our Library contract. It would appear that staying with the Boone library would offer a slightly larger selection of online material to the residents. Residents would still be able to obtain cards for either library. Clean up Days are June 10th and 11th. There will be a dumpster on Pilot street across from Decks as well as a trailer from Pickets for metal and appliances. Anybody willing to volunteer time to help people move junk to the dumpsters please contact a council person.

The old City Hall needs the power entering the back of the building updated and buried. Options are being looked. Wisecup Trucking looked at the 2nd section of the building for removal and estimated \$2000 to do the demolition work. They did recommend making plans for the repairing the wall that would be exposed and having a plan for the drainage issues that would be caused.

New Business:

A number of homes and properties have been sold in town recently and some others are being cleaned up. Hopefully this trend can be continued.

The City is looking to update get updated contact information for Residents. We would like to have a way of efficiently communicating with people besides water bills.

Motion by Crouch, second by Heslop to approve paying the bills. Unanimous vote.

Motion by Acuff, second by Conis to adjourn. Unanimous vote.
